Freddie Mac Announces that CSS Will Perform Securities Administration Duties on Single-Family REMIC Program

Freddie Mac has engaged Common Securitization Solutions, LLC (CSS) to perform certain securities administration duties for Freddie Mac's Single-Family REMIC program. Effective August 1, 2024, CSS will begin acting as registrar, transfer agent, paying agent and authenticating agent for Single-Family REMIC residual certificates, which are issued in registered, certificated form. CSS will engage J.P. Morgan Chase to assist in the paying agent role.

On its Multifamily REMIC program, Freddie Mac will continue performing securities administration duties in the usual course.

Freddie Mac no longer has a physical pick-up window for any newly issued Single-Family REMIC residuals. The submission of Single-Family REMIC residuals for transfer or final distribution will continue to be by mail only, at Common Securitization Solutions, LLC, 7501 Wisconsin Avenue, Suite 400W, Bethesda, MD 20814.
