

Freddie Mac Announces Transition and Consolidation of Certain MBS Disclosure Files

January 27, 2026

Today Freddie Mac announced that, at the end of Q1 2026, U.S. FinTech will begin to support disclosure activities related to Freddie Mac ARM, modified and reinstated securities and will take action to consolidate MBS disclosures files and to retire several pool-level disclosures.

Consolidation of MBS disclosure files

Currently, Freddie Mac publishes one set of disclosure files specific to fixed-rate securities and another set specific to ARM, modified and reinstated securities. With this transition, Freddie Mac will consolidate all MBS disclosures into one set of files.

Effective April 1, 2026, the following MBS disclosure files will be retired:

There is no impact to Pseudopool and Multi Class disclosure files; they will not be consolidated.

Retirement of Disclosure Stratifications

Effective April 1, 2026, the following four pool-level stratifications specific to modified and/or reinstated securities will no longer be published:

- Deferred UPB Stratification (Record type 30) – *This issuance and monthly stratification for modified securities will be retired.*
- Next Step Rate Adjustment Date Stratification (Record type 35) – *This issuance and monthly stratification for modified securities will be retired.*
- Borrower Payment History Stratification (Record type 42) – *This at-issuance stratification for modified and reinstated securities will be retired.*
- Borrower Assistance Plan History Stratification (Record type 48) – *This at-issuance stratification for modified and reinstated securities will be retired.*

Consolidation of Tax Files

Beginning in January 2027, the ARM, modified, and reinstated securities (Single Class) and ARM Strip securities (Multi Class) will be consolidated with the Fixed-Rate securities in the File 1 tax files. However, the set of File 2 tax files will continue to be published for MultiFamily securities.
