

Reminder: Freddie Mac Will Close the Gold PC / Giant PC Exchange Offer on December 18, 2026

June 24, 2026

As previously [announced](#), Freddie Mac will close its offer to investors to exchange certain eligible Gold PCs and Giant PCs for TBA-eligible and non-TBA eligible mirror securities on December 18, 2026. The last day to book an exchange will be December 16 for final settlement of the exchange on December 18.

Following the exchange retirement date of December 18, Freddie Mac will continue to accept 45-day REMIC bonds for reversal into 55-day Reverse REMICs. The transaction would return a 55-day security, but Freddie Mac will not pay float compensation in connection with the transaction. Freddie Mac will also continue to support aggregation of 45-day collateral into 45-day Giant PCs.
